Sehr geehrte Parlamentarierinnen und Kommilitoninnen, Im Folgenden möchte ich Ihnen meine Tätigkeiten des letzten Monats vorstellen.

➤ Office Hours:

Office hours with appointments (until all shut down due to Coronavirus, happening online where possible and meeting where necessary) to solve the problems of international students and to facilitate them in various ways. Every student is welcome no matter German or international to avail support regarding any problems or information or coordination needed. Gather all problems in these hours, and work on solving them the whole week. However, available on call and via e-mail and still providing services.

> Update of problems due to Coronavirus:

Flights cancelled at the last moment, majority of new incoming international
students were not able to reach Paderborn, reserved rooms were to be paid rent.



- Students about to arrive as soon their flights open. Providing them documentational/legal support to smoothen their journey.
- Trying to answer their technical queries related to policies due to Corona.
- o International students who arrived, almost settled.
- o Matriculation deadline finished, no more matriculations.
- Difficult for new comers to understand systems of working, making it easy through various support.

> Inregio:

Again supporting the project to survive further. Played part of documentation from our side to extend the project and its funding for next year. Also planning online workshops and events through Inregio.

Co-ordination:

Active groups which were for international students, need to be kept alive. Planning further measures to support them.

Accommodation and Job situation:

Still in process of resolving problems related to accommodations and supporting students who lost jobs at time of Corona. For accommodation, many extra places which were arranged, are being taken care of. Also students who will now reach Germany after flights resume, need a contract before arrive to get allowance to pass through the passport control. As markets opened, many new job offers started opening, turning those towards students.

Miscellaneous:

Many other things including issuing certificates and other letters to scholarship holders and other types of students and coordinating among partner organizations.
